Community Outreach

Details:

RJN has actively engaged communities through our outreach programs, where we have distributed essential supplies and conducted educational sessions. This initiative aims to improve sexual and reproductive health rights (SRHR) awareness and access to necessary health products.

Outcome:

- Increased awareness and provided essential SRHR resources.
- Distributed over 10,000 condoms, 5,000 units of lubricant, and significant quantities of clothes to underprivileged communities.
- Conducted 50 SRHR educational talks.
- Enhanced community understanding of SRHR and increased safe sex practices.

Mobilization Efforts

Details:

Our dedicated team of mobilizers has been pivotal in gathering data for our projects and disseminating crucial SRHR information across multiple regions.

Outcome:

- Data collection
- Data and information dissemination
- Contribution to research and development

GBV Project – Securing Sanctuary

Details:

This project focuses on advocating for the reopening of state-owned GBV shelters, providing immediate and long-term support to affected individuals.

Outcome:

- Advocated for policy change and provided support to GBV survivors.
- Engaged with policymakers, conducted community workshops, and provided direct support to GBV survivors.
- Raised public awareness and contributed to a national dialogue on GBV, with ongoing discussions about policy reforms.

Period Poverty Initiative

Details:

One of our main focuses is to ensure young girls and women have access to pads and other menstrual products.

Outcome:

- Combat period poverty and improve menstrual health education.
- Distributed 1000 menstrual pads and provided educational sessions on menstrual health to over 100 individuals.
- Improved access to menstrual products and increased knowledge about menstrual health, contributing to better health outcomes and reduced stigma around menstruation.
